Walterdale Theatre Associates – Keeping Volunteers and Patrons Safe

Due to the rising cases of COVID-19 and Walterdale Theatre's desire to continue offering in-person performances, we are updating our policies to keep audience members, staff and volunteers safe. Please note beginning September 20, 2021 Walterdale Theatre will be adopting the Restrictions Exemption Program.

- Only individuals 12 of age or older will be able to access the building
- Every individual who enters the building must show at least one of the following:
 - Proof of COVID-19 vaccination (single dose between Sept. 20 & Oct. 25 if received 2 weeks before access; double doses by Oct. 25) OR
 - Documentation of medical exemption (letter from authorized health professional) OR
 - Proof of a privately-paid negative PCR or rapid test within 72 hours of access (no AHS or Alberta Precision Laboratories' tests)
- Masking is mandatory inside the building at all times except for performers in performance
- No medical records of members/audience members will be scanned or kept by Walterdale.

Other Walterdale Covid-19 safety measures include increased cleaning and sanitization, hand and respiratory hygiene, physical distancing and reduced audience capacity.
